With reference to your letter dated 31.01.2017 received in this office 08.02.2017 on the above subject, I am to inform you as under: -

1 to 5.	<p>M.V.N. University, Palwal, Haryana has been established by an Act of State Legislature of Haryana as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus at regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever its required.</p> <p>M.V.N. University is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University can not open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.</p> <p>The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre.</p> <p>For information related to Distance Education you are requested to approach directly to the Distance Education Bureau of UGC, 35 Ferozeshah Road, New Delhi-110001.</p>
•	<p>Ph.D. is valid if this course is conducted in regular mode at the main campus of the University and as per the provision contained in the UGC MPhil/Ph.D. Regulation, 2016.</p> <p>UGC vide letter No. F. 14-4/2016(PS) dated 25.07.2016 clarified as under:-</p> <p>"It is clarified that Institutions/Colleges who consent to appoint Co-Supervisor from outside the Department/Faculty/College/Institution because of the fact that topics are of inter-disciplinary nature and they feel that the expertise has to be supplemented from outside, the University/College/Institution may do so provided that the terms and conditions are specified by the Research Advisory Committee.</p> <p>It is further clarified that the Supervisor has to form amongst the regular faculty of the host University/College/Institution and only Co-Supervisor can be appointed from outside the University/College/Institution."</p>
