#Independent Study Presentation – I and II:

Each student would be required to give a presentation on any contemporary area of relevance related to the broad subjects of study in the particular semester at the end of the semester. The presentation(s) will be evaluated by the University appointed examiners in I and II Semester End Term Examinations respectively.

*** Internship based Summer Training Report – I and II:**

Each student would be required to undergo internship training after II and IV Semester University examinations for duration of 4-6 weeks and write a report based on the internship carried out. The report will be evaluated by the University appointed examiners in III and V Semester End Term Examinations respectively.

****Departmental Electives – I, II, III and IV:**

A student will be required to select one Departmental Elective paper (from Departmental Elective Group I) in III Semester and one Departmental Elective paper (from Departmental Elective Group II) in IV Semester. Likewise, each student will be required to select one Departmental Elective paper (from Departmental Elective Group III) in V Semester and one Departmental Elective paper (from Departmental Elective Group IV) in VI Semester.

The Department will announce in the beginning of the respective semester, the list of electives which will be offered during the semester depending upon the available resources and the demand of electives from students.

*****Open Electives – I and II:**

A student will be required to select any one Open Elective paper in V Semester and VI Semester respectively (from the common approved pool of open electives floated by University from different Schools).The Department will announce in the beginning of the respective semester, the list of electives which will be offered during the semester depending upon the availability of resources and the demand of electives.

******Minor Project:**

Each student would be required to write a minor project report based on secondary data. The student will write a project report under the supervision of a faculty member assigned by the Department. The Project Report will be evaluated both internally and externally by the University appointed examiners.

*******Major Project:**

Each student would be required to write a major project report based on field study and/or secondary data. The student will write a project report under the supervision of a faculty member assigned by the Department. The Project Report will be evaluated both internally and externally by the University appointed examiners.

+Current Business Affairs – I and II:

Each student would be required to present/participate in the current business affairs sessions pertaining to the concerned semester on a regular basis in class under the supervision of a faculty member assigned by the Department. The current business affairs knowledge of a student will be evaluated both internally and externally by the University appointed examiners via presentations/viva-voce/discussions.

^Comprehensive Viva-Voce

Each student would be required to appear for a comprehensive viva-voce of all subjects taught during the programme (all semesters) at the end of the VI semester. The same will be evaluated by the University appointed examiners in the VI Semester End Term Examinations.
